

LICENCE DEED

[], [description of entity and address details] ("**the Licensor**")

IN FAVOUR OF

THE STATE OF VICTORIA ("**State**")

RECITALS:

- A. The Licensor owns certain materials, set out in the Annexure ("**the Materials**").
- B. The Department of Human Services ("**the Department**") wishes to use, reproduce and adapt the Materials for a compilation of Tools and Case Studies for the Workforce Redesign Resource Project to be published by the Department in hard copy and on State sponsored websites ("**the Websites**") for distribution to health service providers.
- C. The Licensor has agreed to allow the use of the Materials by the Department as described in Recital B on the terms set out in this Deed.

NOW THIS DEED WITNESSES:

1. This Licence commences on the date it is executed by the Licensor.
2. The Licensor licenses, on a perpetual, irrevocable, non-exclusive, worldwide, royalty-free basis, the Department on behalf of the State to:
 - (a) use, reproduce, publish, modify, adapt, distribute and sub-licence the Materials in all formats for the purposes set out in paragraph B of the Recitals; and
 - (b) allow users of the Websites to reproduce the Materials for educational, research or other non-commercial purposes.
3. If the Department wishes to change the Materials it will, if practicable, first tell the Licensor about the proposed changes and discuss the changes with the Licensor.
4. The Licensor must procure the consent of the author to the Department doing or omitting to do anything that, but for this consent, would constitute an infringement of any moral rights that the author has in the Materials including: reproducing, publishing, performing, transmitting, exhibiting, adapting, altering or in any way changing or using the Materials:
 - (a) with or without attribution of authorship;
 - (b) with or without any other materials comprising copyright;
 - (c) with or without any other text, data, sounds or images;
 - (d) with no title, the same title or any other title;
 - (e) in any medium or context,

in any way that the Department sees fit for the purposes set out in paragraph B of the Recitals.

5. The Department does not have to use the Materials on the Websites. The Department can remove all or part of the Materials from the Websites for any reason. It does not have to tell the Licensor about this.
6. The Department will acknowledge in any publication that the Materials were provided or endorsed by the Licensor. The Department can reproduce the Licensor's logo, trademark, or other insignia, or link to its worldwide website, on the Websites for the purpose of this acknowledgment. The Department may decide how and where this acknowledgement is reproduced.
7. The Licensor warrants that the Materials:
 - (a) are of high quality;
 - (b) are factually correct;
 - (c) conform with proper professional standards in the relevant discipline; and
 - (d) are fit for the purposes of publication and will continue to be fit for these purposes.
8. This Licence is governed by the laws of the State of Victoria.
